The Friends of Over Silton Church raise funds to maintain the medieval church of St Mary's, which is half a mile to the east of the village of Over Silton.



The *Bench Mark Challenge* starts at St Mary's and heads east along Kirk Ings Lane then turns north rising up Skirt Bank and along Moor Lane before turning west and looping back into Over Silton through the woods.

The challenge is to find all five Ordnance Survey bench marks which are on the route. The original marks were carved in stone and used to plot the contours for the original Ordnance Survey maps.



Bench Mark I - At the bottom of the west wall of the church

From the church head south along the foot path and turn left, heading east along Kirk Ings Lane.

Bench Mark 2 - On the buildings at the junction with Kirk Ings Lane and Skirt Bank.

From Kirk Ings Lane turn left up Skirt bank, onto Moor Lane.

Bench Mark 3 - Past the old Kiln on *Moor Lane*, the Bench Mark is on the bridge over Sorrow Beck.

Refeshments - Hunters Hill Car Park

Bench Mark 4 - The Bench Mark can be found at the cycle network sign (it could be on the old building).

From the cycle network sign post, carry on up Red Way, taking the second turning left, heading east.

After .75km, when the track splits, bear right.


At the top of the rise bear left following the main track back to Over Silton.
